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

## Suspension Exhaust Valve

This 132000 and 132100 valves are designed to allow high speed exhausting of air suspensions. It is normally placed in line between the height control valve and the air springs. The dual delivery ports allow flexible tubing arrangement while maximizing the exhaust performance.

The built in pilot port can be used to reset the valve to the closed position (Automatic Reset) when pressurized. Connect this port to the supply line of the brake system and the valve will reset and fill the ride springs when the parking brakes are released. The valve includes a special breather (not a plug) for the pilot port that should used if this feature is not be desired.

- Will not jump back when exhausting.
- Includes auto-reset pilot port.
- 1/4" NPT ports
